GIRL POWER 7 week course

Sports Skills and Physical Confidence Building for Girls

This new course is uniquely tailored for girls and is aimed at building confidence and developing self-esteem in a variety of physical activities.

Girls can sometimes lack self belief simply because they have never been given the opportunity to play and practise equally.

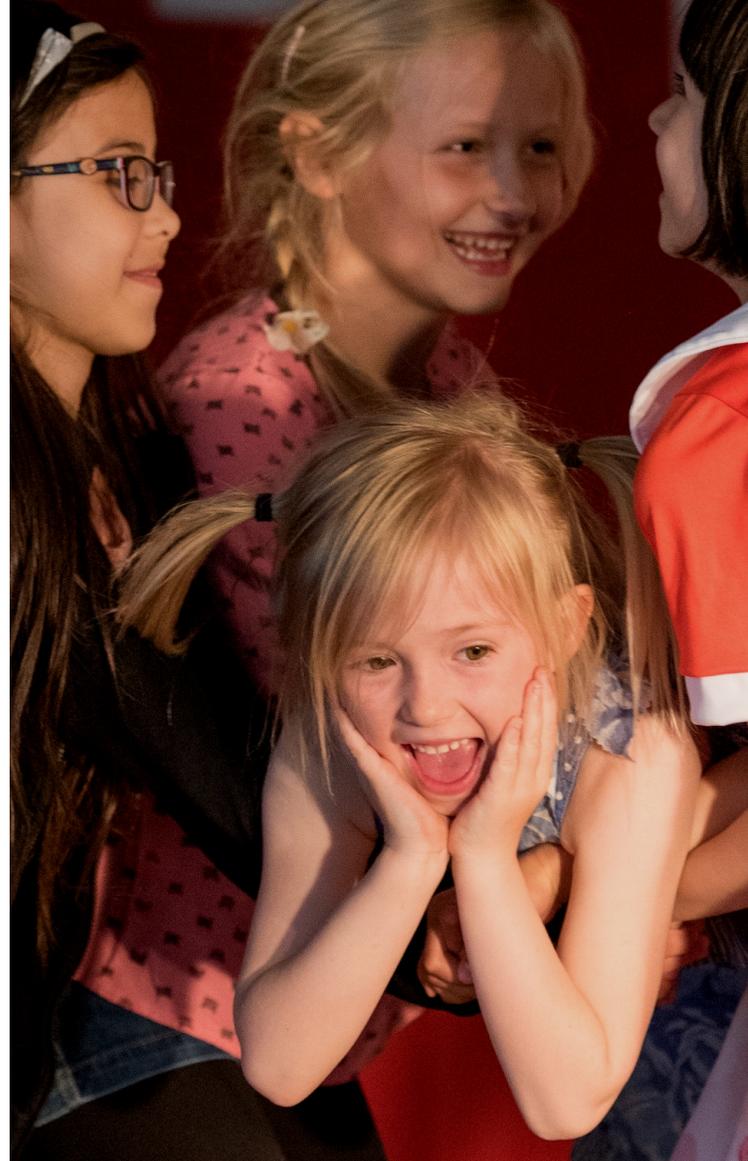
Good self-esteem gives us the courage to try new things, the power to believe in ourselves and the confidence to make healthy choices throughout life.

The mornings will be separated into three sections:

- * Ball skills and sports knowledge focusing on spatial awareness, trajectory skills and hand eye co-ordination.
- * Dance routines exploring individuality, creativity and spontaneity within dance and creative movement.
- * Fitness and health awareness looking at diet and exercise and encouraging a positive body image.

Each session will finish with a yoga inspired stretch and cool down.

Every girl will receive a club folder at the start of the course which includes a skill practise diary, fitness incentives, yoga cards.

DRAMA CLUB

**Fun and learning with acting
and make-believe**

Drama and improvisation games are a fun, dynamic form of play helping children to explore their imagination and enjoy a little escape from reality.

During play we can make mistakes and try things that we wouldn't dare do in everyday life. We learn empathy and understand what it means to be human.

Drama contributes to social and emotional development as we improve our listening and observational skills, learning how to cooperate and how to handle situations and people.

A typical class will begin with a physical or vocal warm up, a short game to create the right atmosphere and to bring the group into the right frame of mind. The group will then tackle the main activity which can vary from improvising a scene, developing a sketch or characters or writing a script. The session will conclude with a cool down, a calm game such as a mime exercise, trust or observation game.
